We can keep Stanley in prayer as he prepares for this mission trip. **Juan and Vicki S** shared with us recently in our evening service, about their work among the refugees in Western Sydney, through Mt Druitt Anglican church. Delivery of food parcels helps in the initial contact with families, who welcome this practical help. Return visits, help to build friendships, as well as any openings to share the Gospel. The years they spent in the Middle East, and speaking Arabic, are good 'ground breakers' in sharing, as many refugees are Muslim faith. Many families are Afghan refugees settling into Australia, but usually one person speaks English which helps with translation.

Now back in Sydney, they are in need of a new rental home, and would value prayer, for the right house with the right price, in the right place.
