Powered and unpowered sites are available for camping (tents, swags, caravans etc.). Dormitories are also available. (Note, the two units on site are already booked). Please note places are limited.

### Program:

Over the weekend we will have some group activities, and plenty of free time too. Planned activities include morning and evening worship times, evening board games and a beach trip.
