Reach Beyond (formerly known as HCJB) write that for over 90 years, they have spread the message of Jesus, bringing hope and transformation worldwide. The dynamic media platforms like WhatsApp and Facebook Messenger, have enabled their impact to reach far beyond their humble beginnings. Countless testimonies bring ongoing encouragement and affirmation of God's power at work. Now in Rohingya, Myanmar, Reach Beyond provide the only Christian radio programs in the region. Daily broadcasts reach remote villages, refugee camps, throughout the Rakhine state. Native speakers communicate directly with their fellow Rohingya. Shortwave radio is the best media tool, as the internet is under military control. Hope through this outreach helps to dispel fear and uncertainty.
