SCREENING AND APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR VOLUNTEERS WORKING WITH CHILDREN

Basso Church has a number of screening and application requirements in place for all staff and volunteers who are looking to be involved in ministry with children and youth under 18 years of age. Some of these screening measures are required by government legislation, and some of these requirements are part of our church exercising a duty of care to ensure we are providing safe ministries, safe environments and safe people within our church, and caring well for those being entrusted to us.

Our current screening and application requirements are:

- Working With Children (WWC) card;
- Basso Church Safe Training;
- o Basso Church Membership (preferred) or progressing towards membership;
- o Code of Conduct for staff/volunteers in Children's Ministry;
- o Volunteer Application form for Children's Ministry (this form), which includes:
 - Agreeing to meet up with one of our ministry team to talk to you about your application;
 - Provision of up to two referees;
 - A questionnaire and declaration.

Working With Children (WWC) Card

All volunteers (who are over 18) that work with children and / or youth (under 18 years of age), are required to apply for a Working With Children (WWC) card.

You will be required to apply for a WWC card prior to joining a team. A copy (or photo) of your application receipt must be provided as evidence that you have applied for a WWC before you can start, and a photo of your WWC card must be provided once it is received. This allows Basso Church to comply with legal requirements for staff and volunteers working with children.

Basso Church Safe Training

You will be required to undergo Basso Church Safe Training prior to commencing in a volunteer role, with training to be renewed every two years. If you are looking to join a team before there is a training opportunity, we will get you to complete a Training Booklet, with the commitment of attending the next in-person training session.



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Basso Church Membership

Church membership provides an environment where the principles of accountability and commitment to the local body of Christ can be lived out. If you are not currently a member of Basso, we would love to talk to you more about this. We want all volunteers to have been a regular part of the Basso congregation for some time, before being involved in ministry, so we know you well.

Code of Conduct for Staff and Volunteers in Children's Ministry

We will provide you a copy of the Code of Conduct to read through as part of this application process. The Church expects all staff and volunteers to uphold the Code of Conduct, which includes expected behaviours for those involved in Children's Ministry at Basso.
